



## **KNA Photography Protocol**

KNA does not take lightly concerns about photography and filming.

All participants (including team officials, parents/guardians and other spectators) at any netball games or activities administered by the KNA or its member clubs are bound by Netball NSW's Member Protection Policy and Netball NSW's Photography Policy on registration. Netball NSW's Member Protection Policy provides emphatically that the safety and welfare of children is paramount above all other considerations. Photography of children in public spaces is prohibited by law in certain circumstances.

Consistent with Netball NSW's Photography Policy, no photography or filming of any netball games or activities administered by the KNA is permitted without prior permission. Any person(s) seeking to take photographs or film should seek permission from the opposition team's manager. If permission is not provided, photography must not occur, and any filming must cease.

### **Effective from Thursday 20 August 2020**

Before you begin photographing or videoing, including live streaming, you will need to ask the Managers of both teams for approval. If either Manager says no, then photography or videoing, including live streaming, is strictly forbidden. This is in line with NNSW policies and now, KNA policy.
