

# Wet Weather

Games are held at Canoon Road at : 8:00, 8:55, 9:45, 10:40, 11:45, 12:50, 2:10, 3:40

Games are held at Lofberg at : 8:00, 9:00, 10:00, 11:00, 12:00, 1:00

The KNA Wet Weather Committee is made up of a representative from the Executive, the Umpires Committee and the Grounds Committee.

The courts at Canoon Rd and Lofberg Rd are ALL WEATHER and decisions are made in light of the conditions prevailing at the time and the safety of the players.

Decisions regarding play of **Net Set Go (NSG) games at Lofberg** will be made in consultation with the NSG Coordinator and may differ from decisions made in relation to play at Canoon Road. If games are cancelled at Lofberg at any time during the Saturday then all games for that day will be cancelled at Lofberg.

Decisions regarding play at **Canoon Rd** will be made prior to 7am on a Saturday, as to whether play will commence as scheduled at 8am or be delayed for 1 or 2 time slots. This information will be posted on the sites located above.

Information will be updated throughout the day in line with changes in weather and playing conditions.

Once a decision has been made for play to commence, games will only be stopped if, in the opinion of the Wet Weather Committee or the umpires on an individual court, conditions become dangerous e.g. lightning is about. Otherwise games continue. Rain itself is not a reason for stopping a game once a game has commenced.

In a rain situation the Umpires may offer the teams the chance to stop the game. If both teams agree and half time has not been reached, the game will be considered an abandoned game (with each team being allocated 1 point). If the game is called off at or after half-time, the scores will stand and the team in front will be declared the winner.

If in the event that one team wishes to continue and one team wishes to stop playing due to the weather conditions, the team that wishes to stop will be declared as forfeiting the game. In this case no score is recorded and two (2) points are awarded to the winning team.

Any games cancelled during the final series will be postponed to the following week.
