



## **MEDICAL EMERGENCY PLAN – CANOON ROAD**

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### **Equipment**

#### **First Aid Kit:**

Locations:                      Physio shelter – southern end of court 1.  
Main complex – score sheets window.

#### **AED (Defibrillator):**

Location:                      Outside wall of the main complex – near court 1.

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### **When calling an ambulance**

**Address:**                      Canoon Road Netball Courts,  
Far end of Canoon Road,  
South Turrumurra,  
New South Wales

**Nearest cross street:** Barwon Avenue

**Ambulance will ask:** What State you are in (answer: NSW)

The address (see above)

What happened

The age and gender of the patient

The patient's awake status

The patient's breathing status

The nature of the injury e.g. are there exposed bones.

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## **Procedures**

In case of medical emergency, the following person is in charge:

The on-site physio.

Emergency response:

1. The person in charge decides whether the emergency can be managed with the First Aid Kit on hand.
- 2. If the Defibrillator is used, dial 000 for an ambulance.**
- 3. If in any doubt, dial 000 for an ambulance.**

When an ambulance is called:

1. Inform the officials in the complex.
2. Members of the grounds committee, or other officials:
  - a. Inform the car park attendant that an ambulance is on the way, and where on the courts the ambulance is to be directed.
  - b. If the ambulance is to be directed to courts 9-12, unlock the access gate to those courts.
  - c. Ensure the access path is clear.
  - d. In conjunction with the car park attendant, direct the ambulance when it arrives.
