Equipment

First Aid Kit:

Location: In the cupboard of the equipment shed adjacent to court 1.

AED (Defibrillator):

Location: Outside wall of the storage shed – near court 1.

When calling an ambulance

Address: Lofberg Road Netball Courts,
Lofberg Road,
West Pymble,
New South Wales

Nearest cross street: Grayling Road

Ambulance will ask: What State you are in (answer: NSW)

The address (see above)

What happened

The age and gender of the patient

The patient's awake status

The patient's breathing status

The nature of the injury e.g. are there exposed bones.

Procedures

Preparation

Prior to taking their duties, the club representatives in charge of grounds duty:

1. Familiarise themselves with the location of all equipment.
2. Familiarise themselves with the operation of the AED (Defibrillator).

In case of medical emergency, the following person is in charge:

1. For a child:
 - a. The child's parent or carer, if present, otherwise
 - b. The team's club-appointed first aid officer, if any, otherwise
 - c. The child's manager or coach, if present, otherwise
 - d. The club representatives in charge of grounds duty at the time.
2. In all other cases:
 - a. The club representatives in charge of grounds duty at the time.

Emergency response:

1. The person in charge decides whether the emergency can be managed with the First Aid Kit on hand.
- 2. If the Defibrillator is used, dial 000 for an ambulance.**
- 3. If in any doubt, dial 000 for an ambulance.**

When an ambulance is called:

1. Inform the club representatives in charge of grounds duty at the time.
2. The club representatives in charge of grounds duty at the time:
 - a. Unlock the access gate at the driveway.
 - b. Ensure the driveway is clear.
 - c. Wait at the driveway to direct the ambulance when it arrives.
